Classic Snowdon

The Multi-Peak Trek route heads away from the town of Llanberis before ascending into the mountains that surround the town.


As you trek ever higher you will conquer a succession of five different summits: Moel Elio, Foel Gron, Foel Goch and Moel Cynghorion, before the grand finale of Yr Wydda, Snowdon itself!

From here the route will descend via the Llanberis path to the finish line and a very well-deserved celebration! The total distance is 21.6km with a total ascent of 1608m. Walking time is approximately 10 hours.

The Classic Snowdon climb route may be slightly shorter, but hiking the highest mountain in England & Wales is still a significant and exciting challenge.

You will head up the valley, away from Llanberis, before joining up with the Snowdon Ranger path and hiking to the mountain peak.

From here you will descend via the beautiful Llanberis path to the finish and a warm welcome back at the hotel. The total distance is 17.5km with a total ascent of 1118m. Walking time is approximately 6 – 7 hours.

Fundraising for Prostate Cancer Research

There are two different fundraising options you can choose when registering for the challenge. Pick the option that works best for you!

Remember the PCR team are on hand for lots of fundraising support.

Option 1: Self-Funding

- Registration Fee: £45.
- Contribution to challenge costs: £65 to be paid 5 weeks (09/05/2026) before departure.
- Fundraising target: Aim to raise as much as you can, 100% of your fundraising will stay with Prostate Cancer Research.



Option 2: Minimum Sponsorship

- Registration Fee: £45.
- Fundraising Target: Aim to raise £360
- We require £65 (covering the cost of your place) to be raised and sent to the charity 7 weeks before the event date, but we also encourage you to raise £360 in minimum sponsorship by 4 weeks post event.
- Prostate Cancer Research will pay the balance of your expedition costs. PCR benefits by keeping the remaining sponsorship money and every pound raised over and above the total challenge cost of £110.


Why support Prostate Cancer Research
